We also attended a Pop Up with the Nevada Homeless Aliance at Share Village where we fed about 100 folks that were weither homeless or living in the nearby housing.

We managed to get him into the Liberty Wellness Center and within 2 months he was able to get into permanent housing! We were able to furnish his entire apartment and get him settled in very nicely!! Clint continues to heal from his burns, and the doctors say he is doing very well! He went back to college at UNLV and looks forward to working very soon!!!

Serving Love Las Vegas sent us a gnetleman that was in need of a job. After talking with him, he came to Vegas for a girl and that did not

He had nothing here so we discussed the possibility of going home and he was thrilled that we were able to send him back to Deleware to be with his family and take care of some health issues he was unable to deal with while in Vegas.



LODGING
